Official use only**8.1****Recommended methods and precautions concerning handling, use, storage, transport or fire****Handling, use and storage:**

Tebuconazole is harmful if swallowed. Suitable protective clothing must be worn, including protective gloves (e.g. of rubber or PVC), closely fitting goggles and in case of dust formation respiratory protection with particle filter, e.g. DIN 3181 P 1.

Suitable container materials:

glass, C-4 clear phenolic coated steel, brass, stainless steel, aluminium, kraft paper and polyethylene.

Kraft paper is not used for the direct contact to tebuconazole, but it is used for the cardboard box (corrugated folding box). Kraft Paper is paper made essentially from wood pulp produced by a modified sulphate pulping process. The word kraft is from the German word for strong.

Tebuconazole and its container must be disposed of as hazardous waste.

Methods of cleaning Up:

Do not empty into drains or waters. Sweep up spilt product with wax-impregnated substance. Avoid formation of dust. Place the collected material in a closable container. To clean the floor and all objects contaminated by this material, use water and detergents

Procedures for waste management of the active substance for industry or professional users

Detailed instructions for safe disposal:

If utilisation or recycling of the product is not possible, it should be disposed of according to the local regulations and laws, e.g. by incineration in a suitable plant. Soiled, empty containers are to be treated in the same way as the contents. For disposal within the EC, the appropriate code according to the European Waste Catalogue (EWC) should be used. It is among the tasks of the polluter to assign the waste to waste codes specific to industrial sectors and processes according to the European Waste Catalogue.
