On authorisation of the biocidal product KILLMETHRIN 2.5 WP

Latvian Environment, Geology and Meteorology Centre (LEGMC) has evaluated an application submitted by **Sharda Europe B.V.B.A** on 29 October 2021 concerning the authorisation of **KILLMETHRIN 2.5 WP** through mutual recognition in sequence.

LEGMC has agreed with Product Assessment Report and Summary of Product Characteristics for **KILLMETHRIN 2.5 WP** developed by the reference Member States – Greece.

Therefore, in accordance with Article 33 of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May 2012 concerning the making available on the market and use of biocidal products (Regulation (EU) No 528/2012), LEGMC authorises the KILLMETHRIN 2.5 WP on the basis of the mutual recognition process.

The authorisation holder for KILLMETHRIN 2.5 WP in Latvia is:

Sharda Europe B.V.B.A

The biocidal product KILLMETHRIN 2.5 WP contains the active substance *deltamethrin* (CAS No 52918-63-5, EC No 258-256-6), concentration 2,538%.

LEGMC assigns the authorisation number for the biocidal product KILLMETHRIN 2.5 WP:

LV/2023/MR/003

The authorisation is valid until 8 October 2028.

The authorisation number shall be indicated on the label of the biocidal product.

The authorisation of **KILLMETHRIN 2.5 WP** through mutual recognition is granted on the following terms:

- Product type: 18 Insecticides, acaricides and products to control other arthropods;
- Target organism: Oriental cockroach adults Blatta orientalis;
- Users: trained professional, professional, general public (non-professional);

- Product description: wettable powder;
- Product stability: 24 months;
- Field of use indoor;
- Pack sizes and packaging material: as indicated in Summary of Product Characteristics.

The authorisation through mutual recognition applies only to the product **KILLMETHRIN 2.5 WP** in the composition, form and packaging for which the first authorisation is granted by reference Member State to **KILLMETHRIN 2.5 WP**.

The information on the label (and if applicable an enclosed instruction of use) of the **KILLMETHRIN 2.5 WP** should be as it is indicated in the first authorisation of the above-mentioned product, taking into account also the information which is stated in the Product Assessment Report and Summary of Product Characteristics issued by reference Member State.

The information on the label shall be in Latvian.

Notwithstanding the content of the label specified above, requirements stated in:

- Article 69 Regulation (EU) No 528/2012;
- Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16
 December 2008 on classification, labelling and packaging of the substances and
 mixtures, amending and repealing Directives 67/548/EEC and 1999/45/EC, and
 amending Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006;
- all other relevant legislation shall be applied.

Sharda Europe B.V.B.A shall inform LEGMC about any changes in accordance with Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 354/2013 of 18th April 2013 on changes of biocidal products authorised in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council.

If the first authorisation issued by the reference Member State is amended or revoked, the authorisation of **KILLMETHRIN 2.5 WP** through mutual recognition may be re-opened for review before 8 October 2028.

Application on renewal of an authorisation shall be submitted according to Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 492/2014 of 7 March 2014 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the rules for the renewal of authorisations of biocidal products subject to mutual recognition.

Additionally, LEGMC would like to inform that Sharda Europe B.V.B.A is fully responsible of the content of the biocidal product **KILLMETHRIN 2.5 WP** as well as its classification, labelling, instruction of use and safety data sheet.

LEGMC would like to ask Sharda Europe B.V.B.A to notify the above-mentioned information down to the supply chain.
