<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	The initial hazard ground of concern has been verified and considered of low priority
<p>The initial hazard ground of concern was suspected PBT. The oximino silanes and their hydrolysis products, are potentially P or vP, however the B criteria is not met. Although the measured BCFs for the hydrolysis product methylethylketoxime (MEKO, CAS 96-29-7) is not reliable, the data on the log Kow of their hydrolysis products ranged from -2.4 to 0.65 showing a low potential for bioaccumulation. Moreover, although the log Koa were estimated ≥ 5, the log Kow were ≤ 2, thus not supporting the potential to bioaccumulate in terrestrial organisms. Therefore, the initial PBT concern can't be supported. Instead, a concern could arise from the re-evaluation of the exposure assessment, considering that the PNEC derivation is inappropriate.</p> <p>A possible follow-up for oximo silanes could be a harmonised classification as MEKO, produced by hydrolysis, is currently listed on Annex VI of CLP Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008) as Carc 2.</p>
