Summary

In accordance with the Article 96 of the REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 and Article 28 of ECHA's Financial Regulation, the Management Board is invited to adopt the 1st amending budget and establishment plan of the Agency for 2012.

Background

There are two reasons calling for amending the Agency's 2012 budget.

Firstly, the Article 16 of ECHA's Financial Regulation states that:

"If the balance of the outturn account within the meaning of Article 81 is positive, it shall be repaid to the Commission up to the amount of the Community subsidy paid during the year. The part of the balance exceeding the amount of the Community subsidy paid during the year shall be entered in the budget for the following year as revenue".

As ECHA has finalised its 2011 accounts, the remaining balance of the budgetary outturn account can now be entered to the budget as revenue.

Secondly, as announced in the document MB/55/2011, Final budget and establishment plan for 2012, the entry into force of the Biocides and PIC Regulations will come along with the budget and the posts necessary to accomplish the respective tasks.

Both Regulations are in the final adoption phase after the legislative authority has agreed on common texts. The financial and human resources become available for ECHA once the legal base is adopted by the legislative authority The Biocides Regulation was adopted by Council on 10 May and will apply from 1 September 2013. The Parliament voted on 10 May in favour of the PIC Regulation. The next step is the Council vote in early June, followed by the entry into force in the first half of July 2012. Entry into operation is scheduled for 1 March 2014.

The Article 28 of ECHA's Financial Regulation states that:

"Any amendment to the budget, including the establishment plan, shall be the subject of an amending budget adopted by the same procedure as the initial budget, in accordance with the provisions of the Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 and Article 27 of this Regulation".



Amendments to the budget

In line with the articles referred to above, the Management Board is invited to adopt the following amendments to ECHA's 2012 budget resulting in a net increase by €18.657 million of the budget total.

Income

<u>Title 1 – Revenue from fees and charges</u>: entry of the positive balance from the budget outturn account of the financial year 2011 totalling \in 230,198,366.61. This balance resulted from the reserve carried forward from last year increased by the fees and charges collected until 31 December 2011, payable pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006, and reduced by the expenses incurred until 31 December 2011.

<u>Title 2 – European Union contributions</u>: entry of the EU subsidy for the funding of Biocides and PIC Regulations, amounting to $\in 2,728$ million and $\in 1,455$ respectively.

Expenditure

<u>Title 1 – Staff</u>: increase by €1,499 million

The amount under Title 1 is increased by the funds foreseen to cover the expenses for the staff employed for the upcoming Biocides and PIC Regulations. There is no change in the amount for the staff employed for REACH and CLP.

<u>Title 2 – Building, equipment and miscellaneous operating expenditure</u>: increase by €0,338 million.

The amount under Title 2 is increased by the funds required to cover the administrative expenses such as rental, utilities and other infrastructure that are necessary to support the staff employed for the two new Regulations. There is no change in the amount foreseen for administrative overheads for REACH and CLP.

<u>Title 4 – Operating Expenditure - Biocides</u>: increase by €1,237 million

The major part of the Biocides operational budget is used for planning and design of new IT tools and upgrade of the existing IT tools that are necessary to support the Biocides operations. This will need significant investment especially as the number of Biocide processes to be supported by IT applications considerably increased as a result of



legislative procedure as compared to the original Commission proposal. Many of these IT tools will have to be in place already from the start of 2013. Other main parts of the operational budget are used for translation of related documents as well as for communication activities necessary to ensure awareness raising among industry concerning the new obligations and the role of ECHA.

Title 5 – Operating Expenditure – PIC: increase by €1,110 million

The biggest part of the PIC budget for 2012 is foreseen for IT development and more specifically for the re-design of the outdated database that supports the management of the export notifications and the import consents. Other main parts are used for scientific studies and consultancy services aiming to support ECHA with the preparatory activities of the new Regulation.

<u>Title 9 – Other expenditure - Reserve</u>: increase by €14,473 million

The amount under this Title is the positive result of the outturn account. It is not intended to be used directly for commitments and payments of expenditure but instead will serve as a balancing item for the reserve. This balancing reserve budget item will be cleared annually against the actual implementation of the expenditure.
