

# DECISION AMENDING DECISION MB/77/2008 ON THE REMUNERATION OF CO-OPTED MEMBERS AND EXPERTS INVITED BY THE ECHA COMMITTEES OR THE FORUM

#### THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN CHEMICALS AGENCY

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), establishing a European Chemicals Agency, amending Directive 1999/45/EC and repealing Council Regulation (EEC) No 793/93 and Commission Regulation (EC) No 1488/94 as well as Council Directive 76/769/EEC and Commission Directives 91/155/EEC, 93/67/EEC, 93/105/EC and 2000/21/EC, and in particular second subparagraph of Article 87(3) thereof,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EC) No 340/2008 of 16 April 2008 on the fees and charges payable to the European Chemicals Agency pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), and in particular Article 15 thereof,

#### WHEREAS

- The Management Board of ECHA adopted decision MB/77/2008 of 18 December 2008 on the remuneration of co-opted members and experts invited by the ECHA Committees and the Forum, which establishes financial arrangements for remunerating co-opted members and experts of the Committees of the European Chemicals Agency (hereinafter referred to as "the Agency") who are not employed in the public service of a Member State;
- 2. In the absence of rules allowing co-opted members not employed in the public service of a Member State to be remunerated for their rapporteur and co-rapporteur work in Agency's Committee, it is necessary to amend the existing decision MB/77/2008 to allow for a good selection of candidates for co-opted membership and to provide the appointed co-opted members a fair level of remuneration for their possible rapporteur and co-rapporteur work.

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

## Article 1

The Decision of the Management Board MB/77/2008 of 18 December 2008 on the remuneration of co-opted members and experts invited by the ECHA Committees and the Forum is amended, as follows:

a) The following sentences are added as a last recital:

"Whereas co-opted members not employed in the public service of a Member State should also be remunerated at a fair level for their rapporteur and co-rapporteur work in their respective Agency Committee in order allow for a good selection of candidates for co-opted membership".

b) The following sentence is added as a second bullet point under Article 1(1):

"Co-opted members of the Committees the Agency for their work as a rapporteur and/or a co-rapporteur"



## c) The following two columns are added to the table under Article 2:

d) The following Article 3 is added after Article 2:

"Article 3 Remuneration for (co-)rapporteurship

- 1. Remuneration for (co-) rapporteurship shall be paid per actual day of work.
- 2. A ceiling of the remuneration per (co-)rapporteurship for co-opted members shall apply."
- e) The existing Article 3 becomes new Article 4
- f) The existing Article 4 becomes new Article 5
- g) The existing Article 5 becomes new Article 6
- h) The existing Article 6 becomes new Article 7
- i) The existing Article 7 becomes new Article 8
- j) The existing Article 8 becomes new Article 9

#### Article 2 Entry into force

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of its adoption. It shall be reviewed by the Management Board 18 month after the adoption.

## Article 3 Publication

This Decision shall be published on the Agency's website.
