Extended expiry date for Scanox AS – Butinox Futura Grunning – NO-2011-0006

With reference to NRN-C-1730198-91-00/F dated 2 May 2024, concerning the expiry date for the biocidal product Butinox Futura Grunning, NO-2011-0006.

Decision

The Norwegian Environment Agency hereby grants Scanox AS a postponement of the expiry date for the authorisation for the biocidal product Butinox Futura Grunning on the Norwegian market. The expiry date is postponed from 30 September 2022 to 31 December 2027.

The product is authorised in Norway under the terms and conditions as described in the final Norwegian Summary Product Characteristic (SPC) attached to the R4BP3 asset no. NO-0003872-0000. The final SPC can also be found on the website of the European Chemicals Agency here: Information on biocides - ECHA (europa.eu).

The grant of extension of expiry date is given in accordance with Article 31(7) of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 (the Biocidal Products Regulation, BPR).

Background

The Biocidal Products Regulation (BPR) is implemented in Norwegian law through the Norwegian Biocide Regulation of 18 April 2017 No 480.

The biocidal product is authorised for use in product-type (PT) 8 (wood preservatives) and contains tebuconazole as the active substance. The expiry date of tebuconazole for use in biocidal products in PT 8 has been postponed by Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2022/1496 until 30 June 2026. Consequently, the expiry date for the biocidal product containing tebuconazole is further extended.



The current expiry date for the Norwegian product authorisation is 30 September 2022.

Evaluation by the Norwegian Environment Agency

This decision is based on the evaluation of the reference Member State.

Right to appeal

This decision may be appealed to the Ministry of Climate and Environment. An appeal shall be submitted to the Norwegian Environment Agency within three weeks after receipt of this letter.
