On an authorisation of Free Land 10EC through mutual recognition in Latvia

Latvian Environment, Geology and Meteorology Centre (LEGMC) has evaluated an application submitted by Activa S.r.l. on 20th May 2020 concerning an authorisation of Free Land 10EC through mutual recognition in parallel.

LEGMC has agreed with Product Assessment Report and Summary of Product Characteristics for **Free Land 10EC** developed by the reference Member State – Greece.

Therefore, in accordance with Article 34 of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May 2012 concerning the making available on the market and use of biocidal products (regulation 528/2012) LEGMC authorises the Free Land 10EC on the basis of mutual recognition process.

The authorisation holder for Free Land 10EC in Latvia is:

Activa S.r.l.

Free Land 10EC contains 10.53 % (w/w) of (RS)-α-cyano-3phenoxybenzyl-(1RS)-cis, trans-3-(2,2-dichlorovinyl)-2,2-dimethylcyclopropanecarboxylate (Cypermethrin) (CAS No. 52315-07-8; EC No. 257-842-9) as active substance.

LEGMC assigns the authorisation number for biocidal product Free Land 10EC:

LV/2023/MR/002

The authorisation is valid until 16th February 2033.

The authorisation number shall be indicated on the label of the biocidal product.

The authorisation of Free Land 10EC through mutual recognition is granted on the following terms:

- Product type: 18 Insecticides, acaricides and products to control other arthropods;
- Target organism German cockroach (Blattella germanica), Oriental cockroach (Blatta orientalis), Garden ant (Lasius niger) and Tiger mosquito (Aedes albopictus);
- Users: trained professionals, professionals and general public;
- Product description: Emulsifiable concentrate;
- Product stability: shelf life 2 years;

The authorisation through mutual recognition applies only to the biocidal product **Free Land 10EC** in the composition, form and packing material for which the first authorisation is granted by reference Member State.



The information on the label (and if applicable an enclosed instruction of use) of the Free Land 10EC should be as it is indicated in the first authorisation of above mentioned biocidal product, taking into account also the information which is stated in the Product Assessment Report and Summary of Product Characteristics issued by reference Member State.

The information on the label shall be in Latvian.

Notwithstanding content of the label specified above, requirements stated in:

- Article 69 of regulation 528/2012,
- Regulation (EC) No. 1272/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 2008 on classification, labelling and packaging of the substances and mixtures, amending and repealing Directives 67/548/EEC and 1999/45/EC, and amending Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006,
- all other relevant legislation shall be applied.

Activa S.r.l. as the authorisation holder shall inform LEGMC about any changes in accordance with *Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 354/2013 of 18th April 2013 on changes of biocidal products authorised in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council.*

If the first authorisation issued by reference Member State is amended or revoked, the authorisation of **Free Land 10EC** through mutual recognition may be re-opened for review before the 16th February 2033.

Additionally, LEGMC would like to inform that **Activa S.r.l.** is fully responsible of the content of the biocidal product **Free Land 10EC** as well as its classification, labelling, instruction of use and safety data sheet.

LEGMC would like to ask **Activa S.r.l.** to notify the above mentioned information down to supply chain.

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
