**5. General directions for use**

**5.1. Instructions for use**

- Sparsely and carefully apply the product on uncovered body parts; equally spread the product on the skin.
- Wear long trousers and/or a long sleeved shirt.
- Do not apply under clothing.
- Keep the spray at least 15 cm from the skin. Do not spray directly onto the face.
- If the product is used in combination with suntan lotion, first apply the suntan lotion and wait for 30 minutes before applying the product.
- In order to protect the face against bites, first apply some of the product on the palm of the hand and then spread over the face..

Restrictions and warnings:

- Do not use in children under 13 years of age.
- Do not use more than once a day.
- Avoid contact with eyes, mucous membranes, nose, lips and damaged skin.
- Do not apply the product on areas where frequent movement of the skin is normal due to bending joints; so do not apply for instance on the back of the knees or elbow pits.
- Avoid contact between the product and food.
- Thoroughly wash hands with water and soap before eating or drinking.
- The use of the product is not indicated for vulnerable groups, pregnant or lactating women.
- Wash treated skin if protection against mosquitoes or ticks is no longer needed or in case of irritation.
- Use the product only in well ventilated rooms or outdoors.
- Avoid contact with synthetic materials (e.g. spectacle frames), synthetic/leather clothing and lacquered surfaces.

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## 5.3. Particulars of likely direct or indirect effects, first aid instructions and emergency measures to protect the environment

First aid measures:

Inhalation: move the victim to fresh air and place in a comfortable position for breathing. Seek medical assistance if the victim feels unwell.

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.

Swallowing: have the victim drink one or two glasses of water, rinse the mouth and induce vomiting by finger in throat. Do not induce vomiting nor insert anything into the mouth when unconscious.

Immediately seek medical assistance if the victim feels unwell.

Contact with open wounds: rinse with plenty of water. Seek medical assistance if irritation persists.

## 5.4. Instructions for safe disposal of the product and its packaging

Do not reuse the flask for other applications. Disposal of contents to a collection point for domestic chemical waste is preferred.

## 5.5. Conditions of storage and shelf-life of the product under normal conditions of storage

The shelf-life of the product is expected to be 5 years in its commercial container.
