## **Extension of the expiry date for the national authorisation of Creosote\_EN\_13991\_BPF - NO-2017-0129**

We refer to the R4BP3 communication of 3 February 2021, 16 February 2021 and 18 February 2021, concerning the expiry date of the authorisation of the biocidal product Creosote\_EN\_13991\_BPF containing the active substance creosote. The Norwegian Environment Agency hereby extend the expiry date until 29 March 2024.

### **Background**

The reference Member State for the re-evaluation, Sweden, has notified the relevant Member States, including Norway, on 18 February that they have extended the authorisation for the biocidal product Creosote\_EN\_13991\_BPF until 29 March 2024 in order to finalise the renewal procedure after the approval of the active substance.

### **Decision**

The Norwegian Environment Agency hereby confirms that the expiry date of the authorisation granted for Creosote\_EN\_13991\_BPF has been extended until 29 March 2024.

Apart from the extension of the expiry date outlined above, the authorisation conditions as state in the authorisation letter dated 27 July 2018 are valid.

No fee will be charged regarding the change of the expiry date.

### **Appeal**

The decision can be appealed to the Ministry of Climate and Environment, in accordance with Article 28 of the Public Administration Act. The complaint must be submitted to the Norwegian Environment Agency within 3 weeks after receipt of this letter, in accordance with Article 29 of the Public Administration Act.
