### 5. General directions for use

#### 5.1. Instructions for use

Apply Care Plus DEET sparingly and carefully to parts of the body that are not covered by clothing; divide the product evenly over the skin.

- Wear long pants and/or long sleeved shirt.
- Keep the spray bottle at least 15 cm from the skin, do not spray directly on the face. To protect the face from insect bites, first spray or spread a small quantity of Care Plus DEET onto the palm of the hand and then spread on the face.

#### 5.2. Risk mitigation measures

#### Restrictions and warnings

- Do not use on children younger than 13 years
- Do not use more than once a day.
- Do not apply under clothing.
- Avoid contact with eyes, mucous membranes, nose, lips and damaged skin.
- Do not apply Care Plus DEET to areas around joints such as behind the knees or inside the elbows where skin folds normally occur.
- When used in combination with sun block lotion, apply sun block first then wait 30 minutes before applying the Care Plus DEET product.
- Avoid contact with food.
- Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water before eating or drinking.
- Application of Care Plus DEET is not advised for sensitive groups such as pregnant and breast feeding women.
- Wash the areas of skin that have been treated when protection is no longer needed or if side effects occur.
- Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area.
- Do not inhale the product.
- Keep this product away from children.
- Avoid contact with plastics (glasses), synthetic-/leather clothing and painted surfaces.

### 5.3. Particulars of likely direct or indirect effects, first aid instructions and emergency measures to protect the environment

Inhalation: move the victim to fresh air and place in a comfortable position for breathing. Seek medical assistance if the victim feels unwell.

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.

Swallowing: have the victim drink one or two glasses of water, rinse the mouth and induce vomiting by finger in throat. Do not induce vomiting nor insert anything into the mouth when unconscious.

Immediately seek medical assistance if the victim feels unwell.

Contact with open wounds: rinse with plenty of water. Seek medical assistance if irritation persists

### 5.4. Instructions for safe disposal of the product and its packaging

Do not reuse the container for any other purpose.

Dispose any remaining product to a waste recycling centre as hazardous waste rather than to domestic waste .

### 5.5. Conditions of storage and shelf-life of the product under normal conditions of storage

The shelf-life of the product is expected to be 5 years in its commercial container.
