Dear Sir/Madam,

The Irish Competent Authority for Biocides, has notified the above product to the Irish market under the Simplified Authorisation Procedure under Art 25 of EU 528/2012, following authorisation by the Latvian Competent Authority. This letter confirms these products may be placed on the Irish market.

For biocidal products to be considered under SAP, the following conditions must be met:

- (a) all the active substances contained in the biocidal product appear in Annex I and satisfy any restriction specified in that Annex;
- (b) the biocidal product does not contain any substance of concern;
- (c) the biocidal product does not contain any nanomaterials;
- (d) the biocidal product is sufficiently effective; and
- (e) the handling of the biocidal product and its intended use do not require personal protective equipment.

The product Tork Surface Disinfecting Spray contains *Lactic acid* as an active substance, which is included in the Annex 1 list for active substances. The following product may be placed on the Irish market:

The product will then be placed on the PCD official register on our website and SALVECO S.A.S. identified as the authorisation holder. Annual fees are liable for Biocidal products placed on the Irish market as indicated the PCD website. In case of any amendments or reclassifications to this product, it is the company's responsibility to inform PCD.
